## BCSSTTC History

The British Columbia Secondary School Table Tennis Championships started as an Inter-School Competition for secondary schools in the Vancouver area in 1970. In the first few championships, schools from around British Columbia were invited. Exhibition matches were also arranged between schools from Washington State, Alberta, and the Yukon.

As more BC Schools competed, the exhibitions matches no longer continued and the BC Secondary Schools Table Tennis Association was formed. In 1981 BC School Sports incorporated Table Tennis into their program and Dr. Chandra Madhosingh became the Commissioner.

Table Tennis continued to flourish in the schools throughout British Columbia with the Championships Venue rotating around the Province including Vernon and Chemainus. Table Tennis Leagues were also developed in Vancouver and Richmond during this time.

In the late 1990s, Table Tennis separated from BC School Sports. With dedicated volunteers and alumni of the tournament, the Championships continued. However, the continued success would not be possible without various sponsors. The British Columbia Table Tennis Association is a major supporter of the championships by providing the use of equipment. Since 2005, Sunrise Soya Foods has been a major sponsor.

## The Importance of BCSSTTC

As part of BC's Healthy Living Initiatives, the BCSSTTC strives to introduce the sport of table tennis to students as an alternative activity to maintain physical fitness. Through this introduction, the Championship hopes that more schools will start table tennis clubs and compete in inter-school leagues in their school districts.

As part of a long term plan for BCTTA and Table Tennis Canada, it is hope that the Championships will be a stepping stone in a junior player's development and identify potential high performance table tennis players.

Past competitors of BCSSTTC have gone on to compete in the Canada Games, the Pan American Games, the Olympics and World Championships.
